Cambodia is home to nearly 18 million people, and most have never heard the true hope that can only be found in the Lord Jesus Christ.

C&MA were the first protestant missions to arrive in Cambodia in 1923,

The New Testament was translated in 1933 and the whole Bible published in 1953.

Its message was not welcome and few believed or obeyed it.

In 1965 the government forced foreign missionaries to withdraw. After 40 years of work, they left the Khmer Evangelical Church (CMA affiliated) with less than one thousand members.

In 1970, there was freedom and growth for the church and the return of missionaries. Many turned to God. There were large evangelistic crusades and Christians laboured with a sense of urgency as the Khmer Rouge advanced. When war broke out there were three congregations in Phnom Penh. By 1975, when the Khmer Rouge took Phnom Penh, this number had increased to 30. Despite Pol Pot's attempt to crush the Church and the pressures on it during the next decades, the small remnant has grown from a few hundred Christians to approximately 250,000 today. There are now more than 2,000 churches.
