Today's Sermon
"God's Testimony"
Pastor Tom
1 John 5: 5-12

*¹¹ And this is the testimony: God
has given us eternal life, and this
life is in his Son. ¹² Whoever has the
Son has life; whoever does not have
the Son of God does not have life.*



God is doing amazing stuff over here. I wish you could see it.

Pray that Pastor Young Soth (who is quite old by Cambodian standards) will be raised up much sooner than the physicians are predicting after he was struck by a motorcycle and suffered a broken leg. He is a man of great faith and has seen many miracles during the days of the Khmer Rouge and afterwards. Soth's belief is so strong he said that there would be no need for surgery. He is in quite a bit of pain, but we had a laugh about what was stronger: *Tylenol or the Creator of the universe?*
Pray that Mary (Dorm Leader) has an opportunity to show how powerful our God is while she is visiting with family at her village.
Pray for the friends and classmates that came to the outreach event at the Dorm and heard about Jesus.

In the Gospel of Mark Jesus proclaims,

*"The time has come, 'the kingdom of God has come near.
Repent and believe the Good News!"*

Notice that the life, preaching and mission of Jesus are predicated upon the assumption that all is not well with us. A salvation religion makes no sense if we're all basically fine, if all we need is a little sprucing up around the edges. Christian saints are those who bear the awful revelation that sin is not simply an abstraction or something that other people wrestle with, but a power that lurks and works in them.

The Good News is Jesus Himself, and it's time to make a decision. When Jesus calls, we have to respond – the time is now.

The kingdom of God is the inbreaking of a new world, one that commands us to change our way of thinking and acting.
